Bemidji State University's Career and Technical Education Core Skills program offers practical experience within the licensure field, focusing on foundational skills, processes, and instructional design. The curriculum begins with the Foundation in Career & Technical Education course, exploring CTE history, Perkins V requirements, and demographic analysis for community implementation. A CTE classroom management course covers effective teaching methods, safety planning, resource management, and strategic planning. The Curriculum Development in CTE course employs backward design and inquiry-based learning, emphasizing Constructivist Learning Theory and creating a Unit of Study on Employability Skills. Career Development Theory & Practice focuses on student-centered lesson planning with a lifetime career development focus. Teacher candidates culminate their experience by defending a portfolio in their CTE career field, assessing prior experience, coursework, and skills relevant to licensure.
