Expectations of Student	<p>The Bemidji State student (teacher candidate) is encouraged to be an active classroom participant and take on opportunities to support the social studies teacher and students.</p> <p>Candidate may conduct observations, work with individual students, work with small groups, co-teach, and assist with planning, curriculum delivery, and assessment.</p> <p>The candidate is required to teach two lessons (expected 40-50 minutes in length); they may utilize the cooperating teacher’s curriculum or create their own lesson materials (depends on the cooperating teachers wishes). The central aim is to gain experience facilitating learning and being in front of the classroom. Overall the main objective communicated to students is to “help, not hinder” the work of the cooperating teacher. We hope our students are responsive and willing to take on several activities to support the demanding work of the classroom.</p>

Expectations of Teacher	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Share curriculum and instructional resources with the student/teacher candidate. • Provide ongoing support and feedback. • Communicate and assist in planning for the two lessons to be taught by the teacher candidate. • Provide teacher candidate opportunities to be an active participant in the classroom. • Share your wisdom and expertise. • Verify student completed field experience hours in SL & L.

Dear Field Experience Cooperating Teacher:

Thank you for hosting a BSU teacher candidate!

We use an online tool, SL&L by Watermark, to track and manage data we need for our program and for teacher licensure. You will be asked to do two things in SL&L:

1. Your teacher candidate will record in SL&L the hours they spend in your classroom. Then, you will go into SL&L and verify those log hours.
2. Near the end of the semester, please complete the brief teacher candidate disposition form in SL&L regarding the candidate's dedication/responsibility, compassion, curiosity, and integrity during their field experience with you. This information allows us to identify and address any dispositional concerns before the teacher candidate begins student teaching. This data will also be utilized to inform change in our teacher preparation program. It should only take a few minutes to complete the form.
