POLITICAL CAMPAIGNING/CANVASSING IN THE RESIDENCE HALLS

All political candidates, all those seeking support for a petition, and all those campaigning to gain support for a referendum shall:

- 1. Notify Housing & Residential Life at least one (1) week in advance of requested canvassing date(s). <u>reslife@bemidjistate.edu</u>, or 218-755-3750 (ask for Director of Housing).
- 2. Candidates may campaign in public areas (lobby), on residence community floors, or in Walnut Hall, and may be joined by up to 5 campaign workers. In the absence of their candidate, campaign workers may ONLY campaign in public areas (lobby or Walnut).
- 3. All candidates and/or representatives and petitioners must check in at the front desk of the appropriate residence hall. All door-to-door canvassing can only be done between the hours of 5-8 pm.
- 4. All candidates and/or representatives agree to wear identification badges provided by Housing & Residential Life and obtained from the front desk.
- 5. All candidates and/or representatives and petitioners must skip any door with a sign indicating they do not want to be canvassed.
- 6. There shall be no materials slid underneath any doors in the residence halls. Literature may be left at the designated table in the lobby or left neatly on/at door.
- 7. Candidates and/or representatives and petitioners may set up information tables in designated areas, with the approval of the Housing Office (this is the encouraged canvassing method in the residence halls)
- 8. No amplified sound may be used.
- 9. Political advertising can be inserted into mailboxes when items are addressed in accordance to USPS guidelines
- 10. Housing & Residential Life stamp authorization is required to post campaign literature on designed bulletin boards. Submit to Housing & Residential Life, Walnut Hall.
- 11. Any request shall fall under the guidelines outlined by Minnesota State Law. Including the need for the candidate to be present for canvassing.

Any candidate and/or representative and petitioner violating these policies are subject to removal from the building by Housing & Residential Life Staff and/or BSU Public Safety.
